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TRANS-EUROPEAN RAILWAY (TER) TRUST FUND

In accordance with the provisions of item II.C. of the Annex to ST/AI/285 it is certified that:

- 1. The trust fund is a technical cooperation trust fund within the guidelines laid down in document ST/SGB/188 and that it meets the other policies and guidelines laid down in the same document.
- 2. That there are no additional financial implications to the regular budget other than those to be met by programme support costs.
