


Project title: Forum of Mayors: Strengthening capacities of UNECE member States on sustainable urban development, housing and land management		
Expected timing/ duration: February – December 2023		
Objective and brief summary of the project: Following the success Forum of Mayors in October 2020 and in April 2022, a third Forum will be held at the Palais des Nations in Geneva, Switzerland on 2-3 October 2023. The Forum will be held back-to-back with the Committee on Urban Development, Housing and Land Management to link local and national actions in support of the achievement of the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals. As in previous years, the Forum will reflect the increasing need to involve local stakeholders towards meeting the SDGs targets and provide a platform for local authorities in the UNECE region to share best practices to tackle different issues, including COVID-19 recovery, urban sustainability, affordable housing, sustainable transport and mobility, climate action and others. The objective of this project is to strengthen capacities of the UNECE member States on sustainable urban development, housing and land management. It will create a space to discuss and share experiences and initiate a network of colleagues from different countries in the region to share ideas and innovation. The objective of the Forum will be achieved by implementing the following activities: A1.1. Organisation of the Forum of Mayors in 2023; A2.1. Organisation of effective communication on the Forum of Mayors (social media, news B-roll production for the news agencies, videos of mayors to share on social media, webcast services, exhibition, brochure website for the event); The Forum of Mayors promotes human-centred solutions for supporting the successful implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and contributes to achieving coherence and complementarity between the local, regional and global levels in furtherance of a stronger, more networked and inclusive multilateral system.

Target group and beneficiaries of the project: The target group are policy makers at the city level (mayors, vice-mayors mainly). Beneficiary countries are UNECE member States.		
Justification of project and its relationship to the programme of work: The Forum of Mayors will be convened in accordance with the decision of the UNECE Executive Committee of 13 January 2023 (document ECE/EX/2023/L.4). The proposed project contributes to the objective of the Subprogramme 8 “Housing, Land Management and Population” “to strengthen member State-owned and city-level programmes and policies promoting decent, adequate, affordable, energy-efficient and healthy housing for all, smart sustainable cities, sustainable urban development and land management, and to advance evidence-based population and social cohesion policies” of the UNECE Programme budget for 2023.
