

**Project title:** Improved communication on the potential of forests in the era of climate change

Expected timing/duration: June 2023 – June 2024

## **Objective and brief summary of the project:**

The objective of the project is to raise awareness of government representatives and stakeholders in the UNECE member States in on forests and their role in climate change mitigation and adaptation in support of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. The project will focus on raising awareness on the linkages between forests and climate change mitigation and adaptation and will include: forest bioeconomy, circularity and forests; carbon neutral building materials - wooden construction; climate change and sustainable consumption and production patterns in forest-based supply chains; food systems and forests; the food-forest-climate nexus; climate change adaptation; climate change impacts and forests (including fires, floods etc.), climate change and boreal forests; biodiversity and the new Global Biodiversity Framework in the forest biome. The project will contribute to strengthening the capacity of the UNECE Committee on Forests and Forest Industry (COFFI) to reach out to relevant constituencies, to draw attention to the international, regional and local priorities in the forest sector and to increase the dissemination of information and tools produced, at national, regional and global levels. The objective of the project will be achieved by implementing the following activity:

A1.1. Organization of 4 awaraness rasing events (at least 2 public relations events on forests and climate change and at least 2 side events) including on the margins of larger international events.

The events will target international organizations and representatives of national governments, on the following occasions and events: International Day of Forests 2024; 2023 United Nations Climate Change Conference/Conference of the Parties of the UNFCCC (COP28); 2024 United Nations Forum on Forests (UNFF). The fourth occasion/event will be specified during the implementation phase.

# **Expected results of the project:**

EA1. Increased awareness of forests and their role in climate change mitigation and adaptation in support of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development.

## Target group and beneficiaries of the project:

Beneficiary countries are UNECE member States. Target audience will include senior government officials from relevant ministries (e.g. agriculture, environment, climate and industry), national experts, representatives of the private sector, civil society, academia.

# Justification of project and its relationship to the programme of work:

The project contributes directly to the objective of the Subprogramme 7 "Forests and the forest industry" of the UNECE program budget for 2023, to "to strengthen the sustainable management of forests and enhance the contribution of forests and forest products to sustainable development in the ECE region." Furthermore, in accordance with the integrated programme of work 2022-2025 of the ECE Committee on Forests and the Forest Industry (COFFI) and the FAO European Forestry Commission (EFC) (ECE/TIM/2021/2, FO:EFC/2021/2), adopted on 25 November 2021, this project supports efforts "to improve the quality of information, ensure international compatibility, provide data storage, dissemination, and analysis of the information" and to promote sustainable forest management and urban forestry.
